



## THE CAMARENA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL-PARENT/GUARDIAN COMPACT

The Camarena Elementary School and the parents/guardians of the students participating in activities and services agree that this compact outlines how the parents/guardians, the entire school staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the state's high standards.

This School-Parent/Guardian Compact is in effect during the 2018 – 2019 school year.

### **School Responsibilities**

Camarena Elementary School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating students to meet the California State Standards (CSS) as follows:
  - The school will provide an effective learning environment that supports the academic, social and emotional, and physical well-being of all students to be college and career ready.
  - The school will provide CSS aligned curriculum and instruction and actively participate in district wide professional development to ensure academic growth and progress for all students.
  - The school will provide and implement high impact, research-based strategies to meet the individual needs of all students.
2. Hold parent/guardian-teacher conferences to review and discuss students' academic, social and emotional progress, achievement, and growth.
  - Parent/guardian-teacher conferences will be held at least 2 times per year or more as requested by the teacher or parent/guardian.
3. Provide parent/guardian with regular reports on their child's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:
  - The classroom teacher will provide weekly communication to the parent/guardian regarding the child's academic progress, work habits, and behavior.
  - The classroom teacher will provide quarterly report cards given at the end of every quarter.
4. Provide parent/guardian reasonable access to school staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
  - Consultation may be by phone, email, or conference/meeting (scheduled by mutual agreement between parent/guardian and teacher).
  - During parent/guardian-teacher conferences held in the fall (September) and the spring (March) of the school year.
  - As requested by parent/guardian and/or teacher with administration.

5. Provide parent/guardian opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class or school and to observe classroom activities.

  - Parent/Guardian Handbook is given to parents/guardians on the first day of school or the first day the child attends Camarena Elementary School.
